

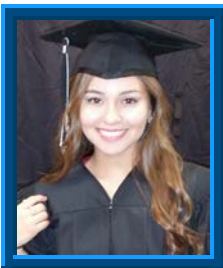


2016 Scholarship Award Winners Say "Thanks"



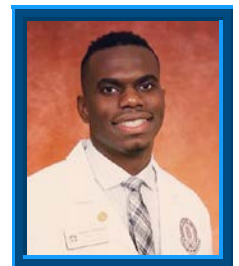
